Are you interested in becoming a Catholic or completing your initiation into the Catholic Church? If so, we have a wonderful opportunity for you. Starting on Saturday, October 7th, we will begin our RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) program. RCIA is a process of learning, growing, and sharing in the Catholic faith. It is designed for:

- Adults who were never baptized and want to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist.
- Baptized Christians from other denominations who wish to join the Catholic Church and receive the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.
- Baptized Catholics who did not receive the sacraments of First Holy Communion and/or Confirmation and want to complete their initiation.

RCIA sessions will be held in the parish rectory on Saturdays from 9:15 am to 10:30 am. You will have the chance to explore the teachings and traditions of the Catholic Church, ask questions, and deepen your relationship with God. You will also be accompanied by a sponsor, a practicing Catholic who will support you and guide you along the way.

If you are interested in attending these sessions, please speak to Fr. Roy or call the parish office for more information. We would love to welcome you into our faith community and journey with you towards the Easter Vigil, where you will receive the sacraments and become a full member of the Catholic Church.

We also encourage parishioners of St. Paul to invite friends, relatives, or neighbors who feel the desire to become Catholic. Our task as baptized members is to bring others to Christ by joining the church he set up for our salvation. Let us share the joy of the Gospel with those who are seeking the truth and the love of God.
