July 28 2024 This weekend, we are pleased to welcome Mrs. Daphne Held as our Co-Op Mission Speaker. Daphne Held is a member of COAR's Board of Directors. She became acquainted with COAR through her involvement with her parish's Charity and Social Justice Commission. During her visits to El Salvador with her parish, she gained an understanding of the needs and challenges faced by the COAR children. After retiring from her business career, she dedicates her time to volunteering in various church and community programs. This has allowed her to experience firsthand the transformative power of charity and solidarity in our church's missions to help the poor and vulnerable. Let me summarize COAR and its impactful work:

COAR (Community Oscar Arnulfo Romero) is a remarkable organization located in Zaragoza, El Salvador. Here are some key points about COAR:

Founding and Purpose:

- COAR was founded in 1980 during El Salvador's brutal civil war by a Cleveland Diocese Mission Team priest, Fr. Ken Myers.
- Fr. Ken, along with fellow Cleveland Mission Team members Sr. Dorothy Kazel, OSU, and Jean Donovan, began gathering orphans from refugee camps and bringing them back to the Mission's parish in Zaragoza.

The "Children's Village":

Today, COAR is known as the "Children's Village" in El Salvador.

- It provides education for 1,000 day students at the school and offers foster care, workshops, and other essential services.
- COAR's motto is "Women and Men for God and Culture," emphasizing holistic education.

Administration and Impact:

- COAR is administered directly by the Archbishop of San Salvador through his Vicariate of Human Development.
- With over 30 employees, COAR plays a vital role in strengthening the regional economy.
- Notably, one of the first orphans from COAR served as the mayor of Zaragoza from 1998 to 2002.

Challenges and Needs:

- Despite its positive impact, El Salvador remains an impoverished country, and COAR's students face significant challenges.
- Basic necessities like food, shelter, and housemothers are crucial for protecting vulnerable children.
- To modernize their education and economy, COAR requires updated computers and new classrooms.


