
Sunday Reflection... written by Joe Gunn

Jesus rejects domination. His ministry serves as the very example of a life of service to the disenfranchised. So, ask yourself - to what do you bow? Before whom do you kneel?



VETCH - GULBIENA

A very beautiful Maltese Christmas tradition is that of decorating the statue of Baby Jesus, or the Nativity Scene, with vetch. According to ancient Maltese tradition, light-deprived vetch seeds are grown over a period of a few weeks and placed next to the statue of the baby Jesus in the manger. Light deprived vetches grow white and stringy. This weekend you can buy your vetch seeds for \$5.00 per packet from the church after Mass or from the Parish Office during office hours.
