Sunday Reflection... written by Anthony Chezzi

We can easily get caught up in the events of life. These moments may be as mundane as driving children to activities, or as serious as a health crisis or marital problems. These matters can cut us off from the presence of God in our lives.

In today's readings, Isaiah, Paul and Matthew urge us to pay attention to the present moment and to be aware of the presence of God in our lives. When we pay attention to our experiences in the present moment, we can start to see God's hand in everything. An awareness of God's presence will change the way we see ourselves and how we relate to the world among us. Our situation may not change, but our ability to move through the situation will change. Aware of God's presence in our lives, we will live in a way that is different from the world around us, as Isaiah, Paul and Matthew teach in the readings.

As we celebrate the Eucharist today, let is pray for the grace to turn our thoughts constantly towards God. Whether in mundane moments such as sitting in traffic, or at more critical times of stress and crisis, every moment is an opportunity to connect with God and change our attitudes, values and actions.

VETCH - ĠULBIENA

A very beautiful Maltese Christmas tradition is that of decorating the statue of Baby Jesus, or the Nativity Scene, with vetch.



According to ancient Maltese tradition, lightdeprived vetch seeds are grown over a period of a few weeks and placed next to the statue of the baby Jesus in the manger. Light deprived vetches grow white and stringy. This weekend you can buy your vetch seeds for \$5.00 per packet from the church after Mass or from the Parish Office during office hours.
