The month of October is dedicated to the **Holy Rosary.** October falls during the liturgical season known as **Ordinary Time**. During October, as in all of Ordinary Time (formerly known as *Time After Pentecost*), the Liturgy does not focus on one particular mystery of Christ, but views the mystery of Christ in all its aspects. We follow the life of Christ through the Gospels, and focus on the teachings and parables of Jesus and what it means for each of us to be a follower of Christ

According to an account by fifteenth-century Dominican, Alan de la Roch, Mary appeared to St. Dominic in 1206 after he had been praying and doing severe penances because of his lack of success in combating the Albigensian heresy. Mary praised him for his valiant fight against the heretics and then gave him the Rosary as a mighty weapon, explained its uses and efficacy, and told him to preach it to others.

On Sunday, November 2nd, Mass for All Souls Day will be at the usual Saturday evening/Sunday Mass times.


The <u>12:00 noon Mass</u> on November 2nd, All Souls Day, will honour those loves ones of our parishioners who passed away this past year.




