First Confession/First Communion


First Confession/First Communion will be offered in the Spring of 2026.

The parent meeting and registration will take place on **NEXT SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 8**, in St. Paul the Apostle Church, following the 12noon Mass.

Baptized Catholic children in grade 2 or higher are eligible to receive the sacraments. Please bring a copy of your child's baptism certificate to the registration **if they were not baptized** at St. Paul's.

An **on-line registration form** is available on our parish website. You can complete it, print it off and bring it with you to the registration. You must attend the registration class. At the registration meeting, you will need to purchase two catechism books for a total of \$25.00. These two books are for class use and for home.

The first class for First Confession will begin Sunday, February 22, at St. Paul's in the museum at 10am. More information on classes etc. will be given at the registration meeting.



MEMORIAL OF ST. BLAISE

This Tuesday, February 3, is the memorial for St. Blaise, bishop and martyr who lived during the 4th century. He is credited with curing a boy who was choking on a fish bone, stuck in his throat. The emperor at the time was amazed but still tried to force Blaise to renounce his faith. Blaise refused and was tortured and beheaded. Eventually, the tradition of blessing throats on his feast day came to be.
